SHRI KALARICKAL PRANCHU FABIAN retired from the Indian Foreign Service in 2000 as Ambassador to Italy, and Permanent Representative to UN in Rome. Since then he has been engaged in the NGO sector (President, Indo-Global Social Service Society; and Action for Food Production); served on the board of directors of Rashtriya Chemicals and Fertilizers, and the Syndicate Bank; held the KPS Menon chair at Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam; and was on the guest faculty of Jawaharlal Nehru University.

Fabian is currently Professor at Indian Society of International Law, New Delhi.

He has authored *Common Sense on War on Iraq; Diplomacy: Indian Style;* and *India in the 21st Century*. His forthcoming publication is *The Arab Spring That Was and Wasn't*.
